
CONFIGURATION

Mains Pressure systems Install the flow restrictor as shown in the restrictor pack.

Unequal Low systems Install as supplied. Equal Low systems Install as supplied.

INSTALLATION (WETRAIL FORMAT)

- Prior to installation, ensure mains water is turned off.
- Remove rail set from pack, detach bottom bracket (internal allen screw), fit soap tray, refit bracket.
- Screw brass tubing to bridge wingback to top supply bracket. Fit top water connection (i.e. remove inlet ferrule from top bracket to do this, being careful not to damage the sealing O-rings).
- Mark bottom bracket location and fit wall disc.
- Slide rail set onto both top and bottom brackets, secure with allen screws and allen tool provided.
- Fit hose and handset.
- Turn on mains.
- Check for leaks.

ADDITIONAL INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALTERNATIVE SUPPLY ELBOW FORMAT

- Utilise additional brass wall bracket insert provided for top bracket.
- Remove rail chrome end thread with allen key, fit chrome cover plug provided.
- Attach the supply elbow to the supply connection on the wall.
- Insert rose, attach hose with conical end to the rose.
